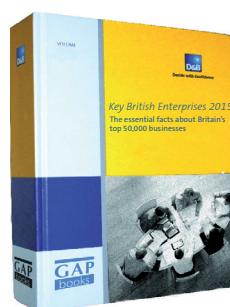

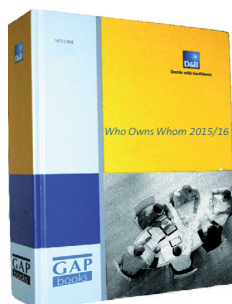

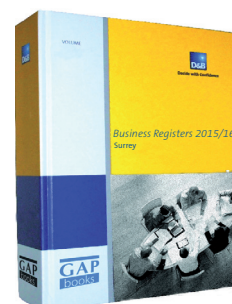

FORMAT

Volumes 1-3 of **Key British Enterprises** list the 50,000 companies alphabetically, with full company information throughout.

Volume 4 provides cross-referencing to the 50,000 companies by industry and post town, county and post town and by principals' names. Volume 4 also includes British Business Rankings, listing the top 5,000 companies from volumes 1-3 and ranking them by employee size, by sales turnover, within each county and within industrial groupings.

BUSINESS LISTINGS

A standard business entry in **Key British Enterprises** includes nearly thirty pieces of information. These are listed below. However it is not always possible to collect every piece of information. For instance sales turnover and profit figures may not be available or there may be no parent company or export markets. To show the incidence and quality of each data element a percentage figure is given in the table below, which indicates the number of business records that have the particular data element. Each business activity has been given equal emphasis, therefore **Key British Enterprises** gives an overview of the main businesses throughout the economy as a whole.

Please note that because of the fluctuating nature of the business world, organisations will constantly be moving into and out of the top 50,000.

How to use Key British Enterprises: SIC Indexes

For indexing purposes **Key British Enterprises** uses the 1972 US Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code system. However the UK SIC Codes appear as data elements in the main entry ensuring that no information is omitted.

SIC Codes are a vital tool in any business research. Market researchers and advertisers rely on them to pinpoint the kinds of business they want to reach. When economists study business segments they use the SIC Code to identify and compare industries - especially when they are analysing changes or trends in business and the economy. Job hunters use SIC's to identify appropriate or interesting prospective employers. Finally SIC Codes are used for hard copy and computer assisted searches in business research everywhere. The letters N.E.C. may appear in the business description, these occur when a full descriptive business operation has not been identified. N.E.C. refers to Not Elsewhere Classified.

US SIC Codes divide all economic activity into ten major groups. These business segments are represented by the first two digits of the SIC Codes:

Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing	01-09	Wholesale Trade	50-51
Mining	10-14	Retail Trade	52-59
Construction	15-17	Finance, Insurance & Real Estate	60-67
Manufacturing	20-39	Business Services	70-79
Transportation, Communication & Public Utilities	40-49	Social Services & Public Administration	80-97

Each line of business is categorised within one of these ten divisions and assigned a code. The first two digits of this code describe the general line of business. The third and fourth digits pinpoint a specific business activity, e.g.

227	Manufacturing - Floor coverings
2272	Manufacturing - Tufted carpets, rugs
